

DISTRICT 90 PREAMBLE:

District 90 of the Southeast Area Assembly of Alcoholics Anonymous shall always be a service body and shall protect and respect the autonomy and the privilege of dissent of any or all A.A. groups in the district service area. In the course of its deliberations and discussions, the District 90 G.S.R. Committee shall ever be mindful of the ideals expressed in the Twelve Traditions, the Twelve Concepts and the A.A. Service Manual and shall strive to be the true voice and group conscience of District 90 Unity.

Service shall be the District 90 G.S.R. Committees primary purpose and shall encourage all District 90 A.A. groups to participate in the business of the District 90 G.S.R. Committee and to support the District 90 G.S.R. Committee in its efforts to cooperate with the Southeast Area Assembly, the A.A. General Service Office and A.A. World Service.

The District 90 G.S.R. Committee is specifically charged with the duty of electing a District Committee Member and Alternate District Committee Member to the Southeast Area Assembly and to give the District Committee Member and Alternate District Committee Member financial support to assist them in the course of the duties of the office. The District 90 G.S.R. Committee is further charged with electing District Officers, as it deems necessary.

STEP 4:

“Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.”

TRADITION 4 (long form):

“With respect to its own affairs, each A.A. group should be responsible to no other authority than its own conscience. But when its plans concern the welfare of neighboring groups also, those groups ought to be consulted. And no group, regional committee, or individual should ever take any action that might greatly affect A.A. as a whole without conferring with the trustees of the General Service Board. On such issues our common welfare is paramount.”

CONCEPT IV:

“At all responsible levels, we ought to maintain a traditional “Right of Participation,” allowing a voting representation in reasonable proportion to the responsibility that each must discharge.”
