TREATMENT FACILITY COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON Revised Job Description 2018

<u>General Description</u>: The District Treatment Facilities Chairperson is elected by the District to serve a two-year term that runs concurrent with the District officers. They are voting members of the District.

Position Duties/Responsibilities:

- 1. Have a working knowledge of the Traditions of AA.
- 2. Chair District Treatment Facilities Committee meetings and report back to the District.
- 3. Act as a contact for the individual District committees and the area committees.
- 4. Submit quarterly written reports to the District on the activity of the committee in the previous quarter.
- 5. Report to the SETA TFC on District activities.
- 6. Attend all District monthly meetings.
- 7. Visit groups within the District as often as possible and encourage participation from the individual members.
- 8. Participate in service workshops and give presentations when asked.
- 9. Answer requests for service at treatment facilities for temporary contacts, meeting support, and presentations to facility staff and patients.
- 10. Contribute committee news to the District newsletter.
- 11. Maintain temporary contact program volunteer list.
- 12. Submit information to the District Website Chairperson as is appropriate to the office.
- 13. At the end of each term all records are to be transferred to the Archives.
